

Abstract Guidelines

CALL FOR PAPERS – SUBMIT YOUR PAPERS NOW!

DEADLINE: 31st MARCH, 2024

Aquaculture Ghana 2024 presents a brilliant opportunity for all aquaculture stakeholders to come together to interact and share new ideas on how to push Ghana's aquaculture industry to the next level. The Aquaculture Ghana 2024 Abstract Committee urges the submission of high quality oral and poster presentations.

The Abstract Committee encourages authors to think about poster presentations, as sessions on poster presentations are important part of the conference. The official language for the conference is English, as such all abstracts must be in English. Each oral presenter shall be entitled to fifteen (15) minutes for a presentation and additional five (5) minutes for questions. Power point will be used for oral presentations.

Abstract book will not be printed, rather an Abstract book will be available online. The Organizers of Aquaculture Ghana 2024 are unable to subsidize travel and accommodation expenses. Presenters are required to bear the full cost of travelling and accommodation expenses.

Instructions for Preparation of Abstracts

Expanded Abstract Format - Please refer to the sample Adopted from World Aquaculture 2017.

TITLE OF PAPER: The abstract title is printed in CAPITAL LETTERS, except for scientific names which should be Upper/lower case and italicized (see example). Scientific names should not be preceded or followed by commas or parentheses or other markings.

AUTHOR(S): The first name should be the presenting author. Use * after the presenting author. Type in upper/lower case.

ADDRESS AND EMAIL: Type only the presenting author's institution, address, and email. Type in upper/lower case.

MAXIMUM LENGTH: One (1) Page **PAGE SIZE:** Standard 8.5 x 11inch paper (portrait)

MARGINS: 1-inch margin throughout (left/right/top/bottom)

SPACING: Single spaced

PARAGRAPHS: Paragraphs should be separated by a blank line and should not be indented.

FONTS: Character fonts should be 12-point type.

FIGURES & TABLES: Figures and tables are highly recommended. They should be reduced to the appropriate size for a one page abstract and should be clearly readable at the reduced size. The reduced figures and tables should be included in the abstract in camera-ready form.
